



Early Years Pupil Premium

All early years providers delivering Government funded early education (including school-based Nurseries) will be able to claim the early years pupil premium for their three and four year old children whose parents/carers are entitled to one or more of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Universal Credit
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)

Three and four year olds will also be eligible if:

- They have been in local authority care for 1 day or more in England or Wales
- They have been adopted from care in England or Wales
- They have left care through a special guardianship order or a child arrangement order in England or Wales

By registering, your child's school could receive an extra £300 per child. Don't delay, register today.
