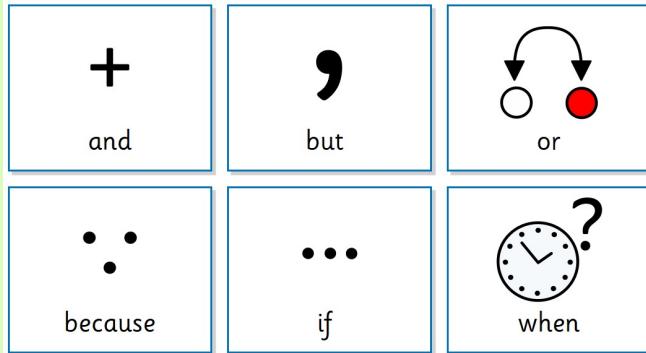


Year 2 Home Learning

Conjunctions are used to add information to a simple sentence.

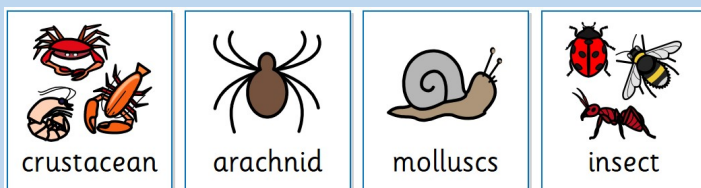
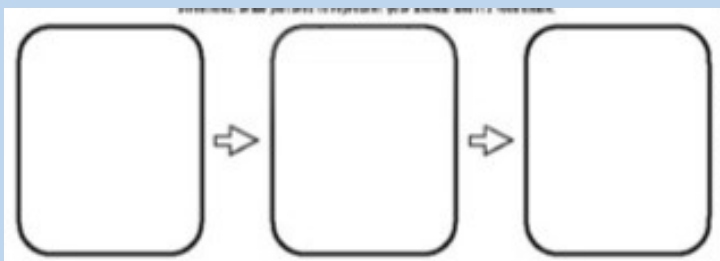
'The oil companies must stop digging for oil near habitats **because** it is harmful to the wildlife'.

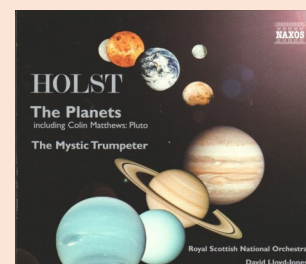
Remember the arrow means 'is eaten by'.
