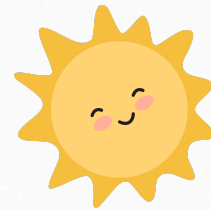

Finally, please do not allow children to bring in individual fans.



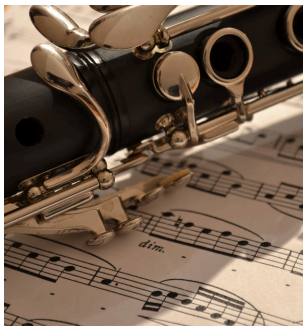
