## Parent-teacher meetings


We are really looking forward to holding our parent-teacher meetings for all classes next week.


## **A message from the Brindishe Friends Group (BFG)**

**The weekend of the Brindishe Big Half is here!!!** On Sunday an amazing team of 22 parents and teachers will run 13.1 miles to raise money for new playground and sports equipment for Brindishe Green. If you want to cheer them on, the first group of runners will leave the school at 8am (onto Hither Green Lane, then Ennersdale Road). The next group 8.10am, the third group 8.20am and the fourth and final group at 8.30am.

See the map for the full route - and here's a guide of where to be (and when) to offer your support:

- Manor House Gardens: start time +10mins
- Blackheath/Greenwich Park: +30mins to 1hr 10
- Thames Path: +1hr 10 to 1hr 20
- Hither Green Lane onto Radford Road: +1hr 40 to 1hr 50
- Mountsfield Park: +1hr 50 to 2hrs
- Hither Green Lane/Torridon Road/Springbank Road/Ethruda Road/Mallet Road/Brightside Road/Nightingale Road/Beacon Road: +2hrs to 2hr 10



The runners will be easily identifiable – they will be wearing navy t-shirts with "Running for Brindishe Green Primary School #doingitforthekids" on the back.
